Animals at Large	Failure to pay damages as assessed by Panel of Review	To be determined by Town Board + current court costs
Junked Vehicles	Failure to remove junked vehicles as prescribed	\$100 to \$500 + current court costs
Rec. Mobile and Motor Home	Failure to display valid annual permit	\$25 per day + current court costs
Junkyard	Failure to obtain required annual permit	\$50 to \$500 + current court costs
	Failure to comply with permit requirements	\$50 to \$500 + current court costs

Driveway	Not obtaining a driveway permit	\$50 + current court costs
	Not complying with prescribed driveway requirements	All costs of bringing driveway into compliance + current court costs

ATV/UTV	Violation of Town, County or State ATV/UTV regulations (see Wis st. 23.33.(13) (a)	Up to \$250 per violation + current court costs
Debris, Junk etc.	Failure to properly dispose of debris, junk, etc	\$100 to \$500 + current court costs
